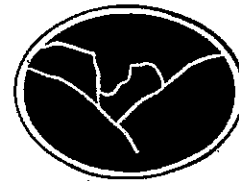

- U= Unknown status
- SS= State listed species of Special Concern
- ST= State listed Threatened Species
- SE= State listed Endangered Species
- FT= Federal listed Threatened Species
- FE= Federal listed Endangered Species
- C1= Candidate for Federal list - sufficient data exists to proceed with listing
- C2= Candidate for Federal list - may warrant listing but insufficient data exists
- N= Non-native,, introduced species to Yosemite
