A= Abundant, can be seen daily in preferred habitat

C= Common, can be seen often in preferred habitat

O= Occasional, seen infrequently in preferred habitat

R= Rare, seen only on rare occasions in preferred habitat

U= Unknown status

SS= State listed species of Special Concern

FT= Federal listed Threatened Species

ST= State listed Threatened Species

FE= Federal listed Endangered Species

SE= State listed Endangered Species

C1= Candidate for Federal list - sufficient data exists to proceed with listing

C2= Candidate for Federal list - may warrant listing but insufficient data exists

N= Non-native, introduced species to Yosemite
